

# GLOPERBA (colchicine)

#### Pre - PA Allowance

# **Prior-Approval Requirements**

Age 18 years of age and older

#### **Diagnosis**

Patient must have the following:

Gout flares

#### **AND ALL** of the following:

- 1. Used as prophylaxis for gout flares
- 2. Patient is unable to swallow or has difficulty swallowing colchicine tablets/capsules
- 3. Prescriber agrees to monitor serum uric acid levels
- Patients with renal OR hepatic impairment only: Gloperba will not be given in conjunction with drugs that inhibit both CYP3A4 and Pglycoprotein (P-gp)
- 5. Prescriber agrees to discontinue Gloperba if patient develops both renal and hepatic impairment
- 6. Prescriber will monitor for colchicine toxicity and neuromuscular toxicity

## **Prior - Approval Limits**

**Quantity** 6 bottles (900 mL) per 90 days

**Duration** 6 months

# Prior – Approval Renewal Requirements

Same as above

## Prior - Approval Renewal Limits

**Quantity** 6 bottles (900 mL) per 90 days

**Duration** 12 months
